

TURNOVER FOR 2008 : 239,5 M€, AN INCREASE OF +1.4%

Velizy, 02 February 2009 – Osiatis, an IT services company specialised in infrastructure services, publishes its turnover for the 2008 financial year.

Osiatis is one of France's foremost IT services companies, renowned as a leader in the field of IT transformation outsourcing, as well as in application developments with new technologies with its subsidiary, Osiaris Ingénierie.

The Group has a workforce of over 3,000 employees and is established in France, Belgium/Luxemburg, Spain and Austria.

61.2 M€ in turnover for the 4th quarter of the 2008 financial year.

Osiatis has recorded a slight increase in consolidated turnover for the 4th quarter of 2008, at 61.2 M€. The slowdown in growth must be relativised in a context which has become clearly more keyed up and after a good 4th quarter in 2007. On the "France" perimeter, turnover has gone up by 0.5% at 53.5 €millions. International business is slightly down for the period (-0.9%) at 7.7 M€. The situations are contrasting between Spain and Belgium which have increased and Austria where figures are down. Per profession, *infrastructure services* have increased by +0.7% and *New Technology Developments* are down by -1.5%. Once again this must be put in the context of a good 4th quarter 2007 concerning this activity.

239.5 M€ in turnover for 2008.

Over the whole 2008 financial year, Osiatis has recorded a turnover of € 239.5 M€, an increase of +1.4% compared with 2007. Turnover for France has attained 208.8 M€ in 2008, an increase of 0.8%. Turnover on the international market has progressed by +6.2% at 30.8 M€.

Infrastructure services business (France and International) has recorded turnover of 201.9 M€, an increase of +2.4%. Applications engineering business (France) has recorded sales of 37.7M€, a drop of -3.4%, taking account of the specialisations made in *New Technology Developments*.

Over the whole financial year, profitability should be in line with what has been recorded over the 1st six-month period.

Perspectives

A high rate of business in France for the 4th quarter, a great deal of repeat business, positioning centred on facilities management and an opportunities portfolio that continues to be well-garnished, enable the company to look at the coming months with confidence.
