Osiatis the infrastructure service specialist has been selected by the French Development Agency (AFD), to carry out migration of its NT4 servers to Active Directory. AFD is the pivotal French operator in state-funded development aid, working on five continents to reduce poverty, fund economic growth and protect global public goods.

AFD brought in Osiatis to migrate its NT4 domain to the Active Directory forest in order to:

- Set up a group strategy (GPO) seeking to optimise the new Active Directory infrastructure via the use of its effective functionalities,
- Transfer all its servers and applications to the new Active Directory domain,
- Decommission the Windows NT4 servers
- Recommend a migration methodology to reduce user impact as far as possible

The AFD will then have at its disposal a durable and open-ended architecture enabling its activities to develop without having to redesign the whole of its architecture.
